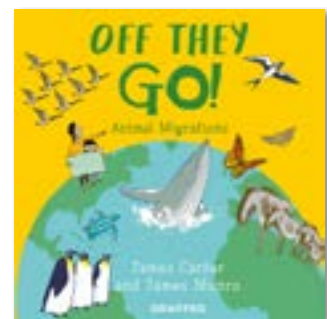

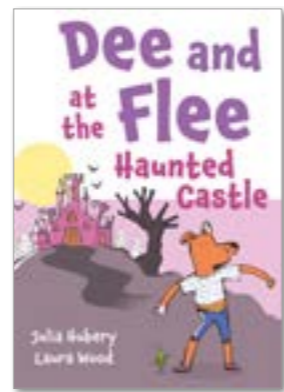
The Bird Thief

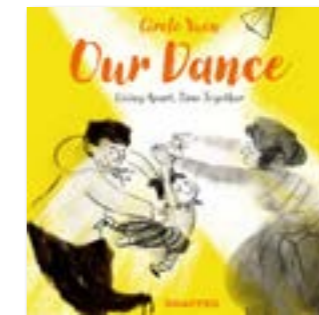
The Neurons series

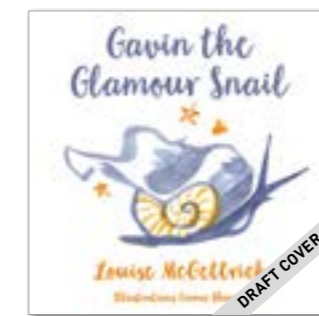
Flow, Water, Flow!

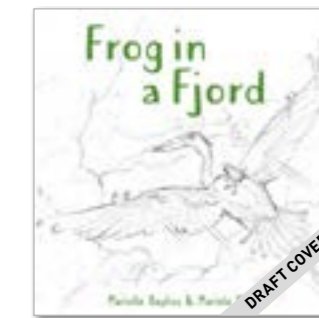
Fletcher and the Bee
